## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**NATIONAL AYURVEDA TEACHING HOSPITAL, BORELLA**

and

**UNIVERSITY OF COLOMBO, SRI LANKA**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as 'MoU' is made and entered into on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022

### BETWEEN

National Ayurveda Teaching Hospital, Borella, Sri Lanka under the Department of Ayurveda, State Ministry of Indigenous Medicine Promotion, Rural and Ayurvedic Hospitals Development and Community Health, Government of Sri Lanka herein named as NATH which is represented by the Commissioner of Ayurveda.

### AND

University of Colombo, Sri Lanka established under the Universities Act No16 of 1978 and its subsequent amendments with its office at No.94, CumaratungaMunidasa Mawatha, Colombo 03 herein named as IIM/ UOC which is represented by the Vice-Chancellor/ University of Colombo.

### WHEREAS

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote indigenous medical education, research and friendly relations, National Ayurveda Teaching Hospital, Borella, Sri Lanka and The Institute of Indigenous Medicine, University of Colombo, Sri Lanka, wish to set out their mutual collaboration intentions in this MoU.

1. Both institutions agree to explore the possibility of cooperation in the fields of teaching, research, and dissemination of knowledge to be agreed upon.
2. Within the disciplinary area of Ayurveda and Unani, both institutions agree to explore the possibilities of cooperation in one or more of the following:
  - 2.1 Establish professorial units at NATH;
  - 2.2 Promoting the teaching including clinical training;
  - 2.3 Promoting collaborative research;
  - 2.4 Consultancy services;
  - 2.5 Exchanging information in fields of mutual interest;
  - 2.6 Organizing training programs;
  - 2.7 Exchanging invitations to scholars;
3. Professorial Unit will demonstrate excellence in indigenous medical professional education and practice; conduct multi-disciplinary research with significant implications for improved patient care and health outcomes; provide exemplary community service, particularly targeted to underserved populations; and train future generations of health professionals and health researchers within the institute environment.
4. NATH agrees to provide to UOC the minimum space necessary to establish professorial units in the hospital building for the conduct of BAMS and BUMS programs.
5. UOC agrees to provide consultants to the professorial unit as honorary consultants **without any extra payments**.
6. NATH agrees to provide all the other staff including special grade officers, senior house officers, house officers, nurses, attendants and other minor staff. All the administrative activities such as patient admission, discharge, transfer will be handled by the hospital administration.
7. UOC agrees to provide the necessary instruments and medical equipment for the effective clinical training.
8. NATH agrees to provide the necessary infrastructure facilities including beds and beddings.
9. The prospective students of BAMS will be allowed to undergo training in the Professorial Units of Kayachikitsa & Deshiya Chikitsa, Shalya Tantra, Shalakyta Tantra, Streeroga Prasutitantra, and Kaumarabhritya and the prospective students of BUMS will be allowed to undergo training in the Professorial Units of Moalejat, Ilmu Jarahat, Amraz-e-Ain, Anf, Uznwa Halq, Amraz e Niswanwa Qabalat, and Ilmu Atfal
10. Each Professorial Unit engages in routine clinics in each specialty and subspecialties at the NATH. Further, clinical trials will also be conducted to generate high-quality research regarding the treatment and prevention of diseases relevant to the Units.
11. Professorial units will be opened for the students and academics during day and night as 24X7.
12. NATH shall maintain the computerized central registration system for maintaining the records of patients in "Out Patient" Department (OPD) and "In Patient" Department (IPD). The NATH shall also maintain the Department wise OPD and IPD records, case papers of OPD and IPD patients, laboratory and radiological investigation reports, medicines dispensing register, diet register for IPD patients, duty roster of hospital staff, birth and death certificates etc to substantiate the claim of genuine functional Ayurveda hospital fulfilling the norms with regards to professorial units.

13. Minimum required space should be determined as per the space requirement given in the table 1 and 2.
14. This MoU will take effect on the date of signature by the representatives of both institutions. It will be valid from the date of signing the MoU.
15. In the event of any differences and disagreement, it would be resolved by discussion between the parties.
